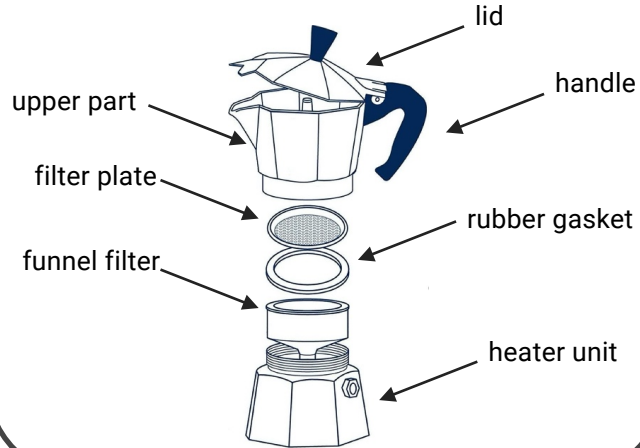


Bialetti Moka Express

Your Moka Pot



Assembling

1. Hold the upper part upside down and drop in the filter plate.
2. Attach the rubber gasket onto the bottom of the heater unit to keep the filter plate in place.
3. Insert the funnel filter into heater unit.
4. Screw the upper part onto heater unit.



Before First-time Use

1. Wash all parts of the Moka pot following the washing instructions below.
2. Brew coffee three times following the brewing instructions below and throw it away.

Brewing Coffee

1.

Fill the heater unit with water up to the level of the safety valve.



2.

Fill the funnel filter with ground coffee, without pressing it down.

Note: Use medium to medium-fine ground coffee.



3.

Insert the funnel filter into the heater unit.

Note: Remove any excess coffee grounds from the rim of the heater unit.



4.

Screw the upper part—with filter plate and gasket attached—onto the heater unit.

Brewing Coffee, cont.

5.

Put the Moka pot on the heat source.

Caution: Keep the flame low. Make sure the flame doesn't exceed the rim of the pot.



6.

When the upper part is full with coffee, remove the Moka pot from the heat source.



7.

Holding the handle, carefully pour your coffee into a cup.



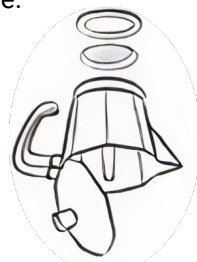
Tip: To fully enjoy the aromas released, drink the coffee as soon as it is poured into the cup.

Washing Instructions

1.

Unscrew the upper part, take out the funnel filter, empty it and wash it.

Note: Wash with water only, using your hands. Do not scrub with an abrasive sponge.



2.

Remove the rubber gasket from the upper part and release the filter plate.

3.

Wash the rubber gasket, filter plate and upper part.



4.

Wash the heater unit.



5.

Let air-dry. Before storing, wipe with a clean cloth.
