How to delete a Whatsapp message

You can delete messages you sent either from your account only (**Delete for me**) or for everyone in the chat where you sent the message (**Delete for Everyone**).

Once the message is deleted, your message will be replaced with "This message was deleted".

If you are an admin of a group, you can use **Delete for Everyone** to delete messages sent by other group participants.

Note: Delete for Everyone is only available 2 days after you send the message.

To delete a message:

- 1. Go to the Whatsapp Group or Whatsapp chat that contains the message you want to delete.
- 2. Tap and hold the message.
- 3. Select **Delete** from the list of options opened.
- 4. You can select:
 - a. Delete for Me to delete the message from your account.
- Note: After you delete a message by selecting **Delete for me**, you have 5 seconds to undo the deletion by clicking **Undo** before the message is permanently deleted.
 - b. **Delete for Everyone** to delete the message for you and all the recipients of the message.
 - c. Cancel, if you do not wish to delete the message.

Whatsapp Chat Options

This is a reference for all the different chat levels and ways in which you can communicate with other whatsapp users.

Chat Option	Description
Individual chat	A chat room for exchanging messages between two Whatsapp users.
	Only the two participants can see their messages to each other in the chat.
Group chat	A chat room where everyone who has been invited or added to the WhatsApp group can chat in a single conversation.
	When a group participant sends a message, all the other group participants can see this message in the group chat.
Community	Communities allow users to organize and bring related groups together in one place.
	Community members can receive updates sent to the entire community.
Broadcast list	Allows users to send the same message simultaneously to multiple (up to 256) Whatsapp users.
	The recipients of the message cannot see the other contacts in the broadcast list.

About the Undo Button

Accidentally deleted a message? The **Undo** button allows you to retrieve your deleted message within 5 seconds. If you don't tap **Undo** within 5 seconds, the message is deleted permanently.

Troubleshooting

WhatsApp video call no sound

If during a Whatsapp video call, the person on the other side can't hear you, try the following:

- Press the volume button to increase the volume.
- Unmute your microphone by clicking the Microphone icon.
 - **Note:** When your microphone is muted, **W** has a white round background.

If this doesn't work, try the following:

- Enable microphone access for Whatsapp

- Clear cache and data of WhatsApp
 - Android: Go to Settings > Apps > All Apps > WhatsApp > Storage & cache, and select Clear Cache.
 - \circ iPhone:

To clear the cache on an iPhone you have to <u>uninstall and reinstall Whatsapp</u> on your iPhone.

FAQ

1. Can I use Whatsapp on my computer?

Yes. To use Whatsapp on your desktop/laptop computer, you can either use Whatsapp Web or Whatsapp Desktop. You can use WhatsApp Web from your computer's browser by linking your account through a QR code from the WhatsApp mobile app. To use the WhatsApp web, the Whatsapp desktop application, you need to download it to your computer and follow the installation instructions.

Yes, you can delete a message after sending it. You can delete a message for yourself at any time, but you only have 2 days after you've sent a message to delete it for all the recipients of the message.
